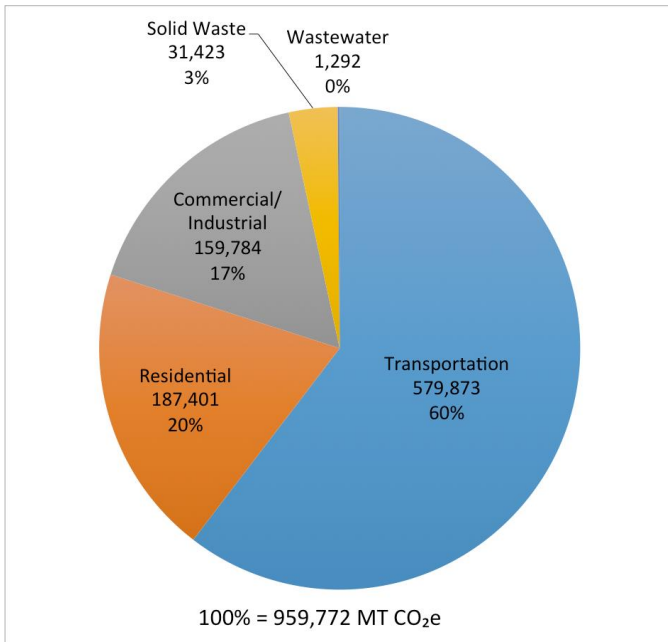

Recommended Targets and Goals*

Long –Term:

ICLEI (Local Governments for Sustainability)

recommends that the City's near term climate work should be guided by the long-term goal of reducing its emissions by 80-95% from the 2005 baseline level by the year 2050.

State Targets:

Executive Order S-B-05 adopts emissions targets for the State:

Reduce emissions to 2000 levels by 2010

Reduce emissions to 1990 levels by 2020

Reduce emissions to 80% below 1990 levels by 2050

AB-32 Scoping Plan provides guidance on establishing targets for local governments:

The plan suggests creating an emission reduction goal of 15% below "current" (2005) levels by 2020. Most local governments in CA that have adopted targets are aiming for 15-25% reductions under 2005 levels by 2020.
